COURSE GOAL:

Acquiring knowledge about medicine, definition of medicine; Seeing medicine in relation to other scientific disciplines; Understanding the importance of medicine for the social community and the individual; Familiarity with different approaches and definitions of health and disease; Understanding the doctor-patient relationship in the treatment process; Acquaintance with basic terms in medicine; Understanding medical terminology and abbreviations; Acquiring knowledge about medical terms derived from Latin and ancient Greek; Acquiring knowledge about basic medical terms in the Serbian language.

COURSE OUTCOME:

Upon completion of classes in Introduction to Medicine and Medical Terminology, the student will be able to:

• Defines medicine content-wise and methodologically;

• Considers medicine in relation to other scientific disciplines and its importance for society and the individual;

• Understands the doctor-patient relationship in the treatment process and recognizes different approaches to health and illness;

• Understands basic medical terms in Serbian, as well as terms derived from Latin and ancient Greek.

ASSESSMENT:

SEMINAR PAPERS: In this way, the student can earn up to 20 points. Each student receives a topic for a seminar paper in each module that he teaches in written form. The preparation, content and form of the seminar paper are evaluated. A list of topics for seminar papers will be offered to students in the first term of the course.

EVALUATION OF THE CLINICAL SEMINAR: In this way, the student can gain up to 20 points. Preparedness, manner of presentation, inclusion of others in the discussion are evaluated. A list of topics for clinical seminars will be offered to students in the first term of the course (one seminar can be prepared by one or more students).

FINAL TEST: In this way, the student can gain up to 60 points.

The final grade is formed as follows:

In order to pass the course, the student must obtain a minimum of 51 points, namely:

1. obtains more than 50% of the points provided for the seminar work

2. obtain more than 50% of the points provided for the clinical seminar

3. pass the final test, i.e. have more than 50% correct answers.
